Contest Rules:

- The Candidate must be a current member in good standing of the Ontario Quarter Horse Association, and have had been a member for a minimum of one year prior to entering the OQHA Queen Contest.
- The Candidate must be a current resident of the province of Ontario.
- The Candidate must be between the ages of 18 and 25 as of January 1st of the current year. She must also be single, never married, divorced, or be a parent.
- A non-refundable \$25.00 entry fee along with an 8x10 photo or high resolution digital photo must also accompanied the candidate’s application and be received no later then Monday May 2nd, 2011 in order for it to be eligible.
- All Contestants will partake in a written test (knowledge of the OQHA By-laws and Constitution and the current AQHA rule book). An oral interviewed conducted by a panel of judges, which will elaborate on the candidates’ application. Poise and personality will also be considered; and finally Horsemanship will be judged by AQHA judges or qualified judges. The contestant does not have to ride her own horse, but must use a registered Quarter Horse.
- The sores shall be calculated as follows: 40% written test, 40% oral interview and 20% horsemanship. The Candidate with the highest overall percentage score will be crowned the winner.
- The Candidate should she be successful and win the 2011 Ontario Quarter Horse Association Queen title, will be required to sign a legally binding contract between herself and the Ontario Quarter Horse Association Inc. If for any reason the terms and conditions of the contract cannot be met, the 2011 Queen title may be revoked at the digression of the Ontario Quarter Horse Association Inc. Board of Directors.
